



Prospectus for Non-Juried Large Art Canterbury Art Show... a *Tapestry of the Arts*

September 4 - September 6, 2021

We are pleased to present this NON-JURIED Large Art Prospectus in the Call to Artists for participation in the 2021 **Canterbury Art Show... a *Tapestry of the Arts***, a premier local exhibition and sale of artwork at St. George's-by-the-River in Rumson, NJ.

This 3-day event will be actively marketed and promoted via the Internet, through social and print media to New Jersey's art community, and through our parish of over 400 members.

This prospectus applies specifically to the NON-JURIED portion of this event. The artwork submitted must be original artwork.

Proceeds from the Canterbury Art Show will directly benefit St. George's-by-the-River Episcopal Church and its many Outreach programs. We are proud of the impactful Outreach programs that serve our community. St. George's awards annual grants to over 30 local agencies including Lunch Break, Family Promise, HABcore, 180 Turning Lives Around, and Love Thy Neighbor, just to name a few.

Some basic information:

- Only those artists who submit an Artist Participation Form and required entry fee(s), no later than the deadline of midnight May 9, 2021, will be considered to be included in the Canterbury Art Show. The Artist Participation Form can be found at www.canterburyartshow.com
- All artwork must be priced with the true intention of selling the artwork.
- The Canterbury Art Show (St. George's-by-the-River) will retain a 30% commission on all artwork sold.
- Any artist who is 18 years of age or older is eligible to participate. There is a separate segment of the show for juried artwork. (See separate prospectus for complete information.)
- No artwork will be accepted without prior registration, an inventory list of submitted artwork, and a digital image.
- The panel reserves the option to accept all or none of your submissions.
- The Canterbury Art Show reserves the right to use digital images of accepted and exhibited artwork for the purpose of media, website, public relations and advertising.
- The Canterbury Art Show is open to the public Saturday, Sunday & Monday of Labor Day Weekend.

Non-Juried Large Art Exhibit and Sale Requirements

Artwork is accepted in the following mediums: Watercolor, Oil, Pastel, Acrylic, Mixed Media, Drawing, Graphic, Photography, Digital Photography, Etching, Lithograph, Silk-Screen, Stone-Block, and Rubbings. Off-set, computer art and crafts are not eligible.

Only those artists who submit an Artist Participation Form and entry fee(s) not later than the **May 9, 2021** midnight deadline will be considered part of the Canterbury Art Show.

Specific Requirements for Non-Juried Large Art Submissions

- The artwork piece does not need to be framed. If on canvas that wraps around the sides of the piece, no staples can be visible. Large artwork must be wired for hanging (tab hangers are not acceptable). All artwork must be completely dry when submitted.
- The artist needs to supply an easel or fixture for displaying the piece.
- All Non-Juried large art must be original.
- Size is in excess of 864 square inches (24 x 36).
- Minimum pricing for all Non-Juried large art is \$400. There is no maximum price.
- A limit of 1 piece of artwork may be submitted.
- Participation is limited to the first 10 received Artist Participation forms with payment.
- If the submitted artwork sells during the show, an artist can submit another piece for a \$25 fee.
- The non-refundable entry fee is \$25*.

***If you choose to enter any 3 categories of the art show –**

Juried, Non-Juried Original, Non-Juried Unframed, Non-Juried Dimensional or Non-Juried Large Art, the discounted fee for 3 categories is \$60.

Non-Juried Large Art Submissions

Non-Juried Large Art Submission Form and Inventory List may be submitted along with the Artist Participation Form or submitted separately later. However, **the non-juried large art submission form and inventory list (including a jpg format image) must be received not later than midnight August 8, 2021.** The accepted artwork must be available for exhibition and sale during the entire show.

There are two ways to submit your artwork:

1. **Submit Form/Artwork Image Online:** Complete the Non-Juried Large Art Submission Form and Inventory List for 1 piece of artwork. List your artwork and upload the jpg image in 72 to 300 dpi jpg format. Complete and submit.
2. **Submit Form/Artwork by Mail:** Complete and mail the Non-Juried Large Art Submission Form and Inventory List for 1 piece of artwork. List your artwork and create a CD with an image of the piece in 72 to 300 dpi jpg format. Clearly label the CD with your name and the title of your artwork. Your CD will not be returned. Deadlines and Important Dates

Sunday, May 9, 2021 Midnight	Deadline to submit the Artist Participation Form and payment of the entry fee(s).
Sunday, August 8, 2021 Midnight	Deadline for receipt of digital image and submission forms for artwork in all Non-Juried segments – Original Art, Non-Framed Art, Dimensional Art, and Large Art. Art-by-Teens submission form deadline.
Sunday, August 15, 2021 12pm – 4pm	Deadline for receipt of Participation Forms for Art from Artists and Artists-at-Work. Notification of accepted Non-Juried piece.
Sunday, August 29, 2021 10am – 4pm	Artist drop-off of all artwork.
Monday, August 30, 2021 10am – 4pm	Artist drop-off of all artwork.
Saturday, Sunday, Monday September 4, 5, 6, 2021	Canterbury Art Show ... a <i>Tapestry of the Arts</i>
Wednesday, September 8, 2021 10am-4pm	Artist pick-up of artwork.
