



Prospectus for Non-Juried Teen Art Canterbury Art Show... a *Tapestry of the Arts*

September 2 - September 4, 2022

We are pleased to present this NON-JURIED Teen Artwork Prospectus in the Call to Artists for participation in the 2022 **Canterbury Art Show... a *Tapestry of the Arts***, a premier local exhibition and sale of artwork at St. George's-by-the-River in Rumson, NJ.

This 3-day event will be actively marketed and promoted via the Internet, through social and print media to New Jersey's art community, and through our parish of over 400 members.

This prospectus applies specifically to the NON-JURIED portion of this event. The artwork submitted must be original artwork.

Proceeds from the Canterbury Art Show will directly benefit St. George's-by-the-River Episcopal Church and its many Outreach programs. We are proud of the impactful Outreach programs that serve our community. St. George's awards annual grants to over 30 local agencies including Lunch Break, Family Promise, HABcore, 180 Turning Lives Around, and Love Thy Neighbor, just to name a few.

Some basic information:

- Only those artists who submit an Artist Participation Form, not later than the deadline of midnight June 26, 2022, will be considered to be included in the Canterbury Art Show. The Artist Participation Form can be found at www.canterburyartshow.com
- All artwork must be priced with the true intention of selling the artwork.
- The Canterbury Art Show (St. George's-by-the-River) will retain a 30% commission on all artwork sold.
- Any artist who is 13-17 years of age is eligible to participate.
- No artwork will be accepted without prior registration and an inventory list of submitted artwork.
- The panel reserves the option to accept all or none of your submissions.
- The Canterbury Art Show reserves the right to use digital images of accepted and exhibited artwork for the purpose of media, website, public relations and advertising.
- The Canterbury Art Show is open to the public Friday, Saturday and Sunday of Labor Day Weekend.

Non-Juried Teen Art Exhibit and Sale Requirements

Artwork is accepted in the following mediums: Watercolor, Oil, Pastel, Acrylic, Mixed Media, Drawing, Graphic, Photography, Digital Photography, Etching, Lithograph, Silk-Screen, Stone-Block, and Rubbings. Off-set, computer art and crafts are not eligible.

Only those artists who submit an Artist Participation Form not later than the **June 26, 2022** midnight deadline will be considered part of the Canterbury Art Show.

Specific Requirements for Non-Juried Teen Art Submissions

- Entries must be framed or on canvas that wraps around the sides of the piece with no staples visible. All pieces must be wired for hanging (tab hangers are not acceptable).
- All Non-Juried teen art must be original.
- Size is not to exceed 20" x 24", including the frame.
- All artwork must be completely "dry" at drop off.
- There is no minimum or maximum selling price for non-juried Teen artwork.
- A limit of 5 pieces of artwork may be submitted.
- Participation is limited to the first 30 received Artist Participation forms.
- If all submitted artwork sells during the show, an artist can submit more pieces.

Non-Juried Teen Art Submissions

Non-Juried Teen Art Submission Form and Inventory List may be submitted along with the Artist Participation Form or submitted separately later. However, **the non-juried teen art submission form and inventory list must be received not later than midnight August 7, 2022.** The accepted artwork must be available for exhibition and sale during the entire show.

There are two ways to submit your artwork:

1. **Submit Form Online:** Complete the Non-Juried Teen Art Submission Form and Inventory List for 5 pieces of artwork. Complete and submit.
2. **Submit Form by Mail:** Complete, print and mail the Non-Juried Teen Art Submission Form and Inventory List for 5 pieces of artwork. Please mail the form to:

Monday, August 29, 2022 12pm – 4pm	Artist drop-off of all artwork.
