Laury A. Egan is a fine arts photographer who has taught at Brookdale Community College, the Guild of Creative Art, where she is a long-standing exhibiting member and former President of the Board of Directors, and currently offers private classes for professional photographers. Tom's career includes book design and illustrations for The New Yorker, The New York Times, The Atlantic Monthly, Harpers Literary Magazine, among many others. He illustrated the best-selling book series, "Brush Up Your Shakespeare". He was one of the 12 artists chosen for the Canterbury Festival UK, to celebrate the 800 Year Anniversary of the Signing of the Magna Carta in 1215!
